● A wise philosopher once said:
The truth is always temporary.
Well in my case this statement
couldn't have been more true.

Up until 3 years ago I despised
hoof boots, due to so many bad
experiences I have had with riding
mates of mine. Whenever one of
these hoof boots using mates joined
me for a trail ride it always turned out
to be a drama. Either these hard-
plastic shoes got lost or some fiddly
wire broke or even worse the horse's
bulb got rubbed bloody and resulted
into horrible discomfort. So I swore
to myself, never will I ever put these
true evil torture devices on one of my
horse's feet. Ever!!!

Well that was until a little red pony
named Bommel came into my life.
When little Bommel was rescued by
us he was 15 years old, had Cushing
syndrome, was extremely obese and
his hooves were a nightmare. They
were trimmed too short and he had
an abscess. My farrier came to have
a look at them and came to the
conclusion that there was not much he
could do except treating the abscess.
He was afraid that just shoeing him
could trigger Laminitis. So he said to
me: I think it's best if you buy some
boots for your pony. At that very
moment my much beloved farrier
turned into Freddy Krüger making my
worst nightmare come true.

Now what? Well I started googling
and soon stumbled over the **Equine
Fusion All Terrain Jogging Shoes**. I
thought - hey horse sneakers! That's
worth a try. I purchased them with
additional dampening pads and
when they arrived I immediately tried
them on Bommel. I was stunned how
easy they were to put on, just two
Velcro's, no straps or wires and they
fitted perfectly. The dampening pads
reminded me of my own memory
foam insoles, super soft.

Very skeptical we went for
a trail run into the woods.
Pony Bommel started to take
much longer strides almost



immediately. It was like he
was walking on clouds
saying, jibee my feet
don't hurt anymore!
And indeed, much to
my surprise, the All
Terrain Boots did and
still do a fantastic job.

I have been using them the
for past 3 years every single day.
For trail runs which are 8 to 10 km a
day, lunging and jumping and they
perform magnificently. Never have
I lost a boot, whether they were
soaked in water, drenched in mud
or snow, when galloping or bucking,
they always stayed on.

The stud kit works fabulous as well.
We have very long snowy and icy
winters in Switzerland. My pony never
slipped, not even on pure ice. Truly
amazing! But why I love them most is
because my Bommel pony loves them.
After a couple of days using them he
started to lift his feet all by himself

when he saw me preparing
the jogging shoes. Literally
saying, put them on already!

This behaviour assures me
every day that Equine
Fusion All Terrain Boots



are the perfect choice.

I now have a healthy,
slim, well trained pony
who loves to run on
whatever ground. The
shock absorption is

incredible and from what I

can tell so is the break-over point. I
have been using the new **Active
Jogging Shoe** for a couple of weeks
now, which has the same sole as the
All Terrain model. Their performance
and handling is mind-blowing. I was
really looking forward to trying out this
new model, since I had some issues
with the All Terrain Boots as soon as
the Velcro wore out. The inside top
flap started to open on its own. Which
then caused the shoe to turn slightly.
Since the Active Jogging Shoe has no
Velcro on the inside it seemed like the
perfect solution. And indeed, they are.
They are so easy to put on, I could do
it with my eyes closed.

They fit much more secure due to
the single top flap which is closed by
a buckle. The Active Jogging Shoe is
our new favourite!
